Ordinance 2013-1

**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE**

**SECTION 1 - INTENT**

The Town of Lindina, Juneau County adopts the following all-terrain vehicle route for the operation of all-terrain vehicle upon all township roads.

Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighed against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic this ordinance has been created.

**SECTION II – STATUTORY AUTHORITY**

Open usage of township roads is done pursuant to township authority as authorized by 23.33(8) (b). Wis. Stats

The applicable provisions of 23.33 regulating ATV/UTV operation pursuant to routes are adopted.

**SECTION III – ROUTES**

*All township roads will be open to ATV/UTV usage.*

**SECTION IV – CONDITIONS**

As condition for use of township roads, the following conditions shall apply to all operators and passengers;

- A. All ATV/UTV operators shall observe a speed limit of 35-mph.
- B. All operators shall ride single file.
- C. All ATV/UTV operators shall slow vehicle to 10-mph or less when operating within 150 feet of a dwelling.
- D. All ATV/UTV operators shall observe operating hours of 5 a.m. to 11 p.m..
- E. All roads must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12, and NR 64.12(7)
- F. Open year around

#### SECTION V- ENFORCEMENT

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

#### SECTION VI- PENTALIES

Wisconsin State All-Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in s. 23.33(13)(a) Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

#### SECTION VII- SEVERABILTY

The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Township would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be deemed affected.

#### SECTION VIII- EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication. Adopted this 11<sup>th</sup> day of December 2013
