Intent: Opposition to prevailing wage law changes for public works projects

WHEREAS, the 2009-2011 State Budget pending before the State legislature, Prevailing wage law changes for public works projects; and

WHEREAS, according to information handed out a Wisconsin Town Association District Meeting, that was held Saturday March 7, 2009, in Reedsburg, Wisconsin, currently prevailing wage law is required for multi trade projects over \$234,000: and

WHEREAS, the pending prevailing wage law would lower the requirement for all public works projects over \$2,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the pending change to lower the prevailing wage law for public works projects over \$2,000.00 would have a severe impact to local governments, further driving up the cost to maintain roads to reflect the prevailing law change: and


WHEREAS, it will be an added burden to taxpayers.

NOW, THEREFORE BE RESOLVED by the Town Board of Lindina that it opposes any prevailing wage law changes that requirement for public works projects over \$2,000.00 as proposed in the 2009-2011 State Budget pending.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Lindina is hereby directed to mail copies of the herein Resolution to the Governor, State Legislative Representatives, the State Department officials dealing with the subject matter of this Resolution, and such other public officials as the deems appropriate.
